Integration of AI Content Detection Technology



Guidelines for Students

Any assignment that exceeds 25% of AI-generated content will be flagged and will not be accepted by the university. The student will be asked to redo the assignment and resubmit once again.

Using AI tools like ChatGPT, and others, for generating course assignments will be considered the same as receiving assistance from someone else. Hence, this raises the concern that the assignment is not the original work of the student.

Through our AI policy, East Bridge University aims to protect the value and integrity of the education imparted by us. We are always committed to upholding the principles of academic honesty, integrity, and intellectual rigor.
